The Academic Session 2020-21 underwent lots of challenges. At the time when the initiatives of dynamic human beings sound to be at halt, it seemed that the proper flow of education would also come to a standstill, but rational human behavior and innovative

approaches paves ways to counter situation for spontaneity of education.

Through online education, teachers and students could interact with each other and continue the teaching-learning in process. In the frightening environment of Covid-19, we faced many challenges, but the commitment helped us to tackle situation.

The major achievements of the

academic session 2020-21 can roughly be categorized into Academic and Co-scholastic.

The results of the 10th and 12th board exams were as expected. Like previous years, this year also the best result in the district Ambedkarnagar went in the name of Radiant Central Children Academy Jalalpur-Ambedkar Nagar. In class 12 Harshit Bajoria with 98% in Commerce stream and Rishabh Gupta 97% in Science

stream brought laurels, while Anshum Patel held the school flag high, scoring 97.6% in class 10.

In the same year, Rishabh Gupta, Jai Yadav, Mrityunjay Singh and Harsh Kashyap add feather in the school cap by qualifying in JEE-Advanced in their very first attempt.

At a time when teaching and delivering proper study material to the students seemed to be very difficult we initiated teaching on Whatsapp, sharing study material and worksheets in pdf followed by video lectures prepared by the teachers, links of Youtube and worksheets through Google Classroom. To address problem of students, online live classes were also inducted in addition to remedial classes. Demonstration of Lab activity and practical were also shared with the students to facilitate them on how to perform practical when they would get opportunity to perform in Labs. To monitor and assess the effectiveness on the online classes and test students preparedness, periodic test were also conducted regularly via Google Form.

Teachers would liaise with students and parents to establish close connection with them and get

regular feedback about progress of the work of the students. Teacher were available round the clock to address the queries and solve the problems of students.

Half-yearly examinations were conducted in the school in an offline mode. Students participated in exam from their homes under supervision of their parents. This proved to be very fruitful to sustain the Academic interest of students. Apart from teaching, co-curricular activities were also observed online concurrently. Students were given opportunities to participate in Inter House Competitions viz debate, speech, quiz, essay, story telling and poem recitation.

Additionally, Online Morning Assembly, Physical Activities, Celebrations viz Teacher's day, Republic day, Christmas were also observed in which students participated with fervour and enthusiasm.

To promote reading skill and creativity among the students, e-books were also made available online via e-library. Students not only wrote book review but also shared their presentation with teachers.

Empowered teachers play a key role in making the school vibrant. Hence teachers were offered opportunities to get online training from CBSE and other available platforms in addition to in house training both online and offline on various areas i.e. online teaching, recording video lessons, editing videos, preparing documents, creating online test by google form and online conferencing on Google Meet and Zoom App.

In nutshell I can say that with concerted effort of teachers and due support from parents, students remain connected with their teachers and felt as if they were in school usual.

I would like extend my heartfelt gratitude to all my teachers for there incessant effort to combat the challenge thus converting it into opportunities.
